This letter is to assure that all Yageo and Phycomp products (including chip resistor, chip capacitor, leaded resistor, electrolytic capacitor, leaded inductor, chip inductor and antenna) are delivered as set forth in the:

Directive EC/1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the council of 18 December 2006 on Registration, Evaluation and Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals

The YAGEO products are all articles which are specified by the Article 7(1) and 7(2) in REACH regulation.

The YAGEO products are all conform with the Restriction of **ANNEX XVII** of **REACH** regulatory.

In Article 7(1), "The substance is intend to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use" is not the designed function of YAGEO products. So YAGEO do not have obligation to register any substance to ECHA.

As for Article 7(2), YAGEO products comply with **SVHC**(substance of very high concern< 0,1%) mentioned in Article 57 including all chemical substances added per latest Candidate List.
